An antique lining found inside an ottoman lends its pattern to Firle. Derived from the word 'Fierol' meaning overgrown with oak, and the name taken from a village in Sussex, this fabric resembles little nets of plants.

Material: 100% Cotton

Width: Our fabrics are produced with a minimum of 2 cm selvedge on either side of the design., **Pattern**

Repeat: V: 10 cm (3.9 in) H: 46.5 cm (18.3 in) , **Joining Width:** 135.9 cm (53.5 in) ,

Printed Width: 138.5 cm (54.5 in) ,
