\'Hizakura\' or day cherry flower also celebrates the Japanese symbolism of cherry blossoms indicating a time of renewal and the transience of life. The inverse of \'Yozakura\' this fabric was inspired by a fragment originating from the Edo period. This style of cotton print was also traditionally used to make \'Hakama\', a type of Japanese trouser.
