## MEDINA RED

All Robert Kime Ikats are made in the traditional way, hand-dyed and woven on narrow looms in Uzbekistan.

As a fabric type, the pattern of a handwoven Ikat includes runs of colour, small slubs and threads typical of the craft process. The design mirrors itself every two metres, whereupon a narrow undyed line indicates the repeat. This is entirely intentional and serves to underscore the designs' authenticity for which Robert Kime Ikats are unmatched.

**Material:** 60% Silk, 40% Cotton

**Width:** All our Ikats are produced with a c.1 cm selvedge on either side of the design, **Pattern Width:** Between c.30 cm and c.50 cm, **Printed Width:** 35.5cm ,

**Pattern Repeat:** V: Every 2 m, indicated by a narrow undyed line

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
