'Yozakura' or night cherry flower celebrates the Japanese symbolism of cherry blossoms indicating a time of renewal and the fleeting nature of life. Inspired by a fragment originating from the Edo period, this style of cotton print was traditionally used to make 'Hakama', a type of Japanese trouser.

**Material:** 93% Cotton, 7% Linen

**Width:** Our fabrics are produced with a minimum of 2 cm selvedge on either side of the design, **Joining Width:**

136 cm (53.5 in) , **Printed Width:** 137 cm (54 in) ,

**Pattern Repeat:** V: 18.5 cm (7.2 in) H: 13.5 cm (5.3 in) ,
